

#### ABOUT THE RACES

TT or Tourist Trophy racing is described by the American Motorcycle Association, the governing body for organized racing, as using Class C equipment on an irregular course less than a half mile in length. Class C equipment consists of essentially stock motorcycles. They may be stripped down and souped up but the basic design as bore and stroke and frame of the motorcycle cannot be altered. The races are divided into two sizes of motors, the 45 cu. in and the 80 cu. in. The 45 cu. in. includes all motors of flat head design up to 45 cu. in. and overhead valve design up to 30.50 cu. in. Motors larger than 45 cu. in. flat head and 30.50 cu. in. overhead must race in the 80 cu. in. group. The riders are classified as Novice, Amateur, and Expert, depending on their degree of proficiency as determined by performance in past events.

White Flag—Start
Black with White Checkered—Finish
Yellow Flag——One lap to go
Red Flag—Danger on the course, proceed with caution
Red and White Flag——Hold position
Black Flag—Disqualification
